 - Currently we use a die-cut machine that belongs to a student who graduated two years ago. Do we need to purchase our own? Glenn Pace said his wife has one, and Lee Thomas has offered to work with JoAnn's to get good prices on materials we need.

 - Marching Band reading session at the High School for current 8th graders on May 30 from 3:30-5. Students will be bussed from Kimpton to the High School but must be picked up from the high school.
