Starting January 11th, band will be using a Synchronous Model! Simply put, band class will be occurring at the <u>SAME TIME EVERY DAY</u>! Whether your child is A-L, M-Z, Maroon, or Gold, band will occur and students will participate during their scheduled class time:

7th Grade- 1:00-1:45 8th Grade- 1:55-2:40

- * If your child is at school, they will be in <u>Live Band</u> with me in the band room with instruments, music, and pencil.
- * Students at home learning remotely will join the <u>Live Band Zoom Meeting</u> while watching and playing along with instrument, music, and pencil.
- * Attendance will be taken on a daily basis when learning remotely.
